\$142,500 Settlement for Injury Sustained When Dog Jumped on Plaintiff

Defendants knew that Plaintiff had recently undergone a knee replacement and was unsteady on her feet. Defendants failed to restrain their dog despite this knowledge. Plaintiff suffered a fractured hip and needed a hip replacement. The case settled for a total amount of \$142,500.
