Community Hope is the largest nonprofit serving homeless veterans and families in New Jersey. #### **Roots & Wings**

Located in Denville, New Jersey, Roots & Wings provides nurturing support, safe housing, educational support and practical life skills to young adults who have aged out of the child welfare system.
