

Gary R. Botwinick Quoted in Law360 About 2024 Outlook, Estate Tax Exemptions

Gary R. Botwinick, co-managing partner and chair of the firm's [Wills, Trusts & Estates](#) and [Taxation](#) practice groups, was interviewed by Law360 reporter Jake Maher for an article about law firm management in 2024. As a firm leader, Gary said he sees a unique challenge in planning office space while growing the firm's practices, given the impact of remote work. And despite the economic climate, he expects a surge in trusts, estates and tax law services between now and 2026, when the nationwide estate tax exemption is going to be about halved in size, noting, "Our wealthiest clients are going to be scrambling over the next two years to take advantage of exemptions which might go away in 2026."
